

# **Notification on International Payments through IBAN**

Dear Customers,

We inform you that in the Republic of Kosovo as of February 1, 2015, all international payments performed by Türkiye İş Bankası A.Ş. Branches in Kosova will be realized through the IBAN format (International Bank Account Number).

IBAN - (International Bank Account Number) - is an international bank account number - featured 20 characters alphanumeric code that uniquely identifies a bank account at the international level, determined in accordance with the international standard ISO 13616.

It is important to remember that IBAN is not a new account number but simply a new format for an existing account number which is recognized internationally, an existing account number with the prefix XK ( of the Republic of Kosova) to it.

IBAN standard will only apply to international payments and is the primary format for use, in which case this standard will increase the quality of the process of international payments.

Therefore, starting as of February 2, 2015 to each existing customer account or new customer account of our Bank, in the event of sending or receiving international transfers, IBAN number will be generated in accordance with the customer's account.

While, about domestic payments, still will be in use the code number BBAN (Basic Bank Account Number) featured 16 characters that uniquely identifies the account at the national level.
